Important to know: Costs

- €60 application fee (multiple applications 👔 possible without further payment)
- €500 DIT service fee per semester (2 semesters per year)
- €82 student services fee per semester

Note: Your application at DIT is only one part of the process. You must also apply separately to a healthcare institution here to secure a training contract (Ausbildungsvertrag).

Apply to a healthcare facility (from abroad!)



To be eligible for the programme, you **must** have a training contract with a German healthcare

Important: Please look for healthcare facilities in or **near the region of Deggendorf** – to avoid long travel distances during your studies and training.

You must organise this **on your own** from your home country **before enrollment**.

Before you apply, please consider the following:

- In which area would you like to work in the future? (e.g. hospital, outpatient care, long-term residential care)
- Do you already have a preferred healthcare
- Where would you like to live during your practical training phases?
- Are you mobile (do you have a car)?

- 4. If successful, you will receive a **training contract**

You may apply to one of our official partner institutions or to any healthcare facility here. If your institution is not yet a DIT partner, let us know - we'll check if a cooperation is possible.

We highly recommend that you apply for housing as early as possible ideally parallel to your programme and training contract applications.

Step 5: Apply for a student visa (non-EU citizens only)

If you're a non-EU citizen, you must apply for a **study visa** in your home country.



Please make a visa interview appointment with the German embassy or consulate **as early as possible**. Visa processing can take several weeks or even

Receive notice of acceptance or denial

You will be notified about your application status

If accepted:

- Upload remaining documents
- Pay the student services fee
- Take out German health insurance

If denied:

You can reapply after completing missing documents

Visa issuance (non-EU citizens)
