## Proof of Language Proficiency

### Proof of English Language Proficiency

The level of English required to start studying must be proven during the official application period by all applicants. Accepted as proof are:

Graduation certificates (such as German Abitur, with English courses taken continuously to the end of qualification phase 1, i. e. year 11 with G8 and year 12 otherwise and passed with at least "sufficient"), transcripts of records (e.g. from former studies) or language certificates that prove the required level.

For the courses at the European Campus the following requirements must be met:

- Holders of graduation certificates from schools from English-speaking countries (only applies for United Kingdom, Ireland, United States, Australia, New Zealand, Oceania, Canada)
- proof of at least one-year studies at a university in an English-speaking country (only applies for United Kingdom, Ireland, United States, Australia, New Zealand, Oceania, Canada)
- proof of successfully completed university studies in English

For the courses at the European Campus the following requirements must be met:

- Das Österreichische Sprachdiplom Deutsch (ÖSD)
- Das große und das kleine Sprachdiplom oder das Zeugnis der zentralen Oberstufenprüfung (ZOP) des Goethe-Instituts
- Prüfung zum Nachweis deutscher Sprachkenntnisse (PNDS)
- Das Zeugnis der Prüfung zur Feststellung der Eignung ausländischer Studienbewerber für die Aufnahme eines Studiums an Hochschulen in der Bundesrepublik Deutschland (Feststellungsprüfung an einem Studienkolleg in Deutschland) als Sprachnachweis anerkannt.

The following people are exempt from providing German language certificates:

- Holders of German university entrance qualifications (Abitur, Fachhochschulreife, or equivalent, in Germany or at a German school abroad)
- Applicants who have already completed German language studies at a German university or at a university abroad (proof required)
- Applicants who are German native speakers: from Austria, Liechtenstein, South Tirol, Switzerland and Luxembourg
- Holders of "German A (Higher Level)" in the International Baccalaureate
- Holders of Goethe certificate C2

**Language certificates must be less than 2 years old!**
