Note on important regulations for examinations in accordance with the General Examination Regulations (APO, 01/10/2024):

Examination registration (Sect. 17)

- Anyone intending to take examinations must register for the examination in due form and time, stating the modules/subjects, and be admitted to the examination. Examination registration generally takes place online via the student portal during the registration period. Modules or course examinations which cannot be registered via the student portal must be registered with the help of the staff at the Centre for Studies.
- Delayed registrations are only permitted upon written request within a deadline set by the board of examiners, stating valid reasons and with the approval of the chair of the examination committee concerned.
- Withdrawal without consequences from an examination for which a student has already registered is only possible if the student de-registers online via the student portal **at least 7 days before** the examination date. Students are not required to give reasons for their withdrawal. If no official withdrawal has been received and the student has missed the examination for reasons for which they are responsible, the grade "not sufficient" must be awarded.
- An examination is deemed not to have been sat if registration has not been made in due form and time.
- Registration for an examination is only valid for the next examination date. **Admission to a resit or to a missed examination must be applied for again.**

**Resit examinations (Sect. 21)**

The first resit examination (second attempt) must be taken within a period of **twelve** months, the second resit examination (third attempt) must be taken within a period of **six** months after the result of the assessment of the previous resit examination has been announced.

Inability to sit an examination due to illness (Sections 19, 20)

- A medical certificate must be submitted in due time for all absences due to illness. See the announcement regarding the examinations on the DIT website.

**Please be aware of the following points:**

Please check the exam schedule regularly. The examination date may change on very short notice.

After registration, students can only withdraw from an examination if they de-register from the examination **at least seven days** before the date of examination.

The withdrawal from the examination must be made either on the online portal or in written form at the center for studies.

Bring your student-ID with you to each examination!

Mobile phones and any other electronic devices may not be on the desks. They must be turned off completely.

Registration for every re-examination is necessary. There will be no automatic registration!

**Explanation of the authorized tools:**

\* Open book: all tools are allowed, e.g. different book sources, AI (like ChatGPT) is forbidden!

No tools: no tools are allowed, you will only receive the exam paper
